Day 1: Safari starts with a trip to Naivasha

Highlights: Great Rift Valley, Boat Riding, Hell's Gate

Our professional safari driver/guide will pick you up from the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport or hotel in Nairobi and bring you to your safari briefing. After this short introduction, you will be on your way. From Nairobi, you will enjoy a scenic drive through volcanic mountains and lakes providing breathtaking views of the Kenyan landscape. Picnic lunch will be served inside the park.

Upon arriving at Lake Naivasha you will check into your accommodation. You will have time to relax for the remainder of the afternoon. [Optional: Boat rides to Crescent Island on Lake Naivasha.]

You will experience an authentic African dinner in the evening before heading to bed.

Activities

AFTERNOON

Our expert guide will take you on a game drive and you'll see a large number of animals and learn so much about wildlife this afternoon in Hell's Gate National Park.

Get a whole new perspective on Lake Naivasha when you come with us for an excursion by boat. There's so much you'll see that you can't experience any other way

MEALS: LUNCH & DINNER

ACCOMMODATION: Lake Naivasha Sopa Lodge

There aren't many places to stay where you have to be careful of hippos wandering around the hotel grounds at night. Here at Lake Naivasha Sopa Resort, they're just one of many attractions by the lakeshore, including stone bungalows withluxury rooms, a large swimming pool, a bar and a fine restaurant. Apart from the hippos, watch for waterbuck and other antelopes grazing beneath the many trees.







Day 2: Spotting Black Rhinos and Flamingos of Lake Nakuru

Highlights: Rift Valley, Rhinos, Giraffes, Mount Longonot, Flamingos

You're in for a real treat when you visit Lake Nakuru National Park. It's one of the best places anywhere for seeing both black and white rhinos, but there are other highlights as well, including the possibility of seeing lions (some even climb trees here), leopards, flamingos and endangered Rothschild's giraffes. Rich birdlife, pretty acacia forests, and a towering escarpment overlooking the lake all add to the natural drama

ACCOMMODATION: Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge

You'll stay in a corner of Lake Nakuru National Park which Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge has all to itself. The views from just about anywhere in the lodge are the best in the park, and the rooms are large, lovely and filled with light. The facilities are first-rate, from the swimming pool to the bar and restaurant. But it's the location that really sets this place apart.

Activities

MORNING

Transfer by Road, Lake Naivasha Sopa Resort to Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge

AFTERNOON

You'll be joining us in Lake Nakuru National Park for a guided game drive. It's a fantastic opportunity to see some of the animals you came so far to see









Day 3 & 4: Wildebeest Migration and the Big Five of Maasai Mara

Highlights: Wildebeest Migration, African Big Flve, Crocodiles, Hippos

One of our favorite places to look for wildlife is the Masai Mara National Reserve. That's because the wildlife here is incredible, with big cats (lions, leopards and cheetahs) and elephants among the highlights. There's a very good chance you'll also see giraffes, buffaloes, wildebeests, zebras, hippos, hyenas, and, of course, impalas. And bring your binoculars, because more than 500 species of birds have been recorded in the reserve.

ACCOMMODATION: Ashnil Mara Camp

Stay deep in the Masai Mara National Reserve at Ashnil Mara Camp where you'll be surrounded by trees overlooking a bend in the Mara River. You can often see hippos and crocodiles down below the camp. The wood-floored safari tents are luxurious, and everything here is excellent, from the service and the restaurant, to the bar, swimming pool, and the spa center



The guided game drive is the best thing about going on safari and that's what you'll be doing this morning in Masai Mara National Reserve. From the comfort of your vehicle, there's always a chance that you might see some of the animals that you came so far to see.

AFTERNOON

Come and see the best of Masai Mara National Reserve as we take you out on a guided game drive. It really is a terrific way to feel a part of Africa with the wind in your hair as we drive you around to look for animals







Day 5 & 6: Exploring vast landscapes and wildlife in Serengeti

Highlights: Endless plains, a large concentration of wildlife, elephants, dik-dik

You won't find many better national parks in Africa than the Serengeti, which has few rivals when it comes to both the numbers and variety of animals. Track down the annual migration of wildebeest and zebra. Enjoy the vast horizons that are perfect for spotting predators and their prey, as well as elephants and giraffes. If you're really lucky you'll see a hunt, one of the most exhilarating sights anywhere in the wild. And at every turn, revel in its beauty, with flat-topped acacia trees silhouetted against the setting sun, and so many other classic African safari images.

ACCOMMODATION:Malaika Camp

Activities MORNING

DAY 5: Transfer by Road, Masai Mara National Reserve to Malaika Camp DAY 6: There's no better way for you to see Serengeti than on the guided game drive we'll take you on this morning. Get your camera and binoculars ready, sit back in our vehicle, and enjoy looking for the wildlife.

AFTERNOON

You'll be heading down more safari trails in search of animals in Serengeti National Park when we take you on a guided game drive. This is the best thing about many safaris, and you'll hopefully see many animals.





Day 7: Wildlife Haven of Ngorongoro Crater

Highlights: Ngorongoro Crater, Natural Wildlife Haven

Today you'll visit Ngorongoro Crater, one of the most beautiful natural sights in Africa, a place where you'll experience otherworldly beauty with extraordinary wildlife. Watch as, from above, morning mist rolls up and over the crater rim, and notice how the steep walls suggest a place unlike any other. Down below on the crater floor, explore a lost world preserved in a state of pristine isolation, one that shelters lions and hyenas, elephants and black rhinos, flamingos and golden jackals. There are also forests, hippolilled lakes, a salt pan and hyena dens, and you'll never lose the sense that you've stumbled into a safari theme park where everything's wild.

ACCOMMODATION: Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge

Expect high levels of comfort at the Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge, which occupies a fantastic location overlooking the Ngorongoro Crater from on high. Rooms are large and well-appointed, and most have extraordinary views out over the crater. Watch the mist rise from the crater floor, the piercing white of the salt lake at midday, or the lengthening shadows as the day turns the corner towards sunset. A good restaurant with crater views from some tables, as well as a lively bar, round out a memorable package

Activities MORNING

Transfer by Road, Malaika Camp to Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodg

AFTERNOON

Your early morning descent into Ngorongoro Crater on a guided game drive is one of East Africa's best safari experiences. You'll spend most of the day getting to know this special place and its wildlife.







Day 8: After the tree-climbing lions of Lake Manyara

Highlights: Abundance of wildlife, Tree-climbing Lions, The Great Rift Valley

Strung out in the shadow of the Rift Valley escarpment, that great fracture in the earth's surface that divides Africa in two, Lake Manyara is one of Tanzania's more unusual parks. Here you'll certainly see the elephants for which the park is famous, and, if you're really lucky, one of the park's equally wellDknown tree-climbing lions. There's also a lake filled with wading birds, plenty of olive baboons, and dense forests that make you feel that exciting animals could emerge from the trees at any moment. It's a wonderful chance to mark the transition between the lower plains and the Crater Highlands (with Ngorongoro Crater) away to the west.

ACCOMMODATION: L. Manyara Kilimamoja Lodge

You may never want to look away from the views at Lake Manyara Kilimamoja Lodge. You can linger over them from the swimming pool, from the private terrace of many rooms and even from your own bed in some rooms. The lodge's outstanding location has the benefit, too, of being close to Lake Manyara National Park but well removed from the crowds. There's also a restaurant, gym and relaxing gardens.

Activities

MORNING

Transfer by Road, Ngorongoro Serena Lodge to Lake Manyara

AFTERNOON

Take a guided game drive around the forests and along the lakeshore of Lake Manyara National Park, and look for elephants and tree-climbing lions, all in the company of an expert guide.







Day 9: off to Tarangire

Highlights: Ancient Baobab Trees, Herds of Elephants

We think you'll be impressed with Tarangire National Park. Most visitors love the distinct shapes of the baobab trees silhouetted against the sky that make this place feel like a fairy-tale African landscape. Or visitors remember the elephants that roam in family bands everywhere throughout the park. If you're lucky, you'll also encounter the big cats – lions especially, but also cheetahs and leopards – that are always a possibility here. And there's a fair degree of certainty that you will tick wildebeest, giraffe, hippo, buffalo and zebra off your wildlife-viewing list.

ACCOMMODATION: Tarangire Sopa Lodge

Well-placed for exploring the quiet, but wildlife-rich southern sections of Tarangire National Park, Tarangire Sopa Lodge has large rooms decorated with safari prints and warm color schemes. Elephants and baboons are frequent visitors to the hotel, and you might even be able to watch them from your room. With a swimming pool, bar, restaurant and shop, the lodge offers the complete package

Activities MORNING

Transfer by Road, Crest Safari Lodge to Tarangire National Park

AFTERNOON

Come with us as we look for lions, elephants and so much more amid the baobab trees and classic safari scenery of Tarangire National Park







Day 10: Last day of your safari
