Overview

Enjoy the very best game parks such as the legendary Maasai Mara, the untouched wilderness of Samburu and Tsavo, and the rhino's haven in Lake Nakuru. Spend your last days in Diani as you wind down and relax. Experience the natural world unchanged by the passage of time with every comfort and amenity available to you.

Itinerary

Day 1: Safari starts with a transfer to Samburu National Reserve

You're in for a treat when you visit Samburu National Reserve with us. Expect glorious scenery, four of the Big Five (no rhino), hyenas, giraffes, hippos and zebras.

Samburu highlights include some prized northern specialties, such as Somali ostrich, gerenuk, Grevy's zebra, beisa oryx and reticulated giraffe. And bring your binoculars: almost 400 bird species have been seen within the reserve's boundaries.

A rest in Samburu as you prepare for an amazing wildlife adventure.

MEALS: LUNCH & DINNER

ACCOMMODATION: Samburu Sopa Lodge

You're lucky enough to be staying at Samburu Sopa Lodge, a fine, traditional lodge in Samburu National Reserve. Accommodation is in distinctive bungalows with mud walls and thatched roofs, and the rooms are big and filled with safari colors and character. Relax in the bar, restaurant or pool, and you can also look forward to wonderful wildlife experiences close by.



Day 2: Exploring the untouched wilderness of Samburu

Highlights: Elephants, Samburu Special Five, the Samburu People

Beautiful Samburu National Reserve is sure to capture your heart. Some of the scenery, especially close to the riverbank, is spectacular, and the wildlife is terrific. If you're lucky, you'll see all of the big cats, hyena, elephant, giraffe, hippo and zebra. Samburu is well-known for mammals from Kenya's north that can be hard to see elsewhere: gerenuk, Grevy's zebra, beisa oryx and reticulated giraffe. Birders will love the chance to see nearly 400 different species.

Day 3 & 4: Ol Pejeta Conservancy, home to the Big Five & White Rhino Haven

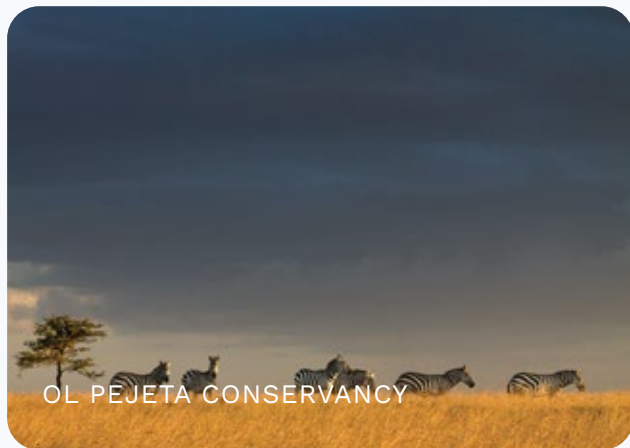
Highlights: Wildlife Conservation, Africa Big Five

Welcome to remarkable Ol Pejeta Conservancy, where there's so much to see, all set against a backdrop of high-altitude savannah and distant hills. It's an important sanctuary for black and white rhinos, is home to the Big Five, and has easy-to-spot populations of elephant, giraffe, buffalo and zebra. There are plenty of predators, including lion, cheetah and hyena as well.

You'll also find the last two remaining northern white rhinos left on earth, a rescue center for chimpanzees, and a bird list with over 500 different species.

ACCOMMODATION: Peaks Hotel Nanyuki

Peaks Hotel Nanyuki will be your base on this leg of your trip.



Activities

MORNING

DAY 3: Transfer by Road to Nanyuki
DAY 4: There's no better way for you to see Ol Pejeta than on the guided game drive we'll take you on this morning. Get your camera and binoculars ready, sit back in our vehicle, and enjoy looking for the wildlife.

AFTERNOON

Explore Ol Pejeta with us as you go looking for the Big Five on a guided game drive through this remarkable place.

Day 5: Safari to the rhino haven & home to pink Flamingos in Lake Nakuru

Highlights: Rift Valley, Rhinos, Giraffes, Mount Longonot, Flamingos

You're in for a real treat when you visit Lake Nakuru National Park. It's one of the best places anywhere for seeing both black and white rhinos, but there are other highlights as well, including the possibility of seeing lions (some even climb trees here), leopards, flamingos and endangered Rothschild's giraffes. Rich birdlife, pretty acacia forests, and a towering escarpment overlooking the lake all add to the natural drama

ACCOMMODATION: Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge

You'll stay in a corner of Lake Nakuru National Park which Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge has all to itself. The views from just about anywhere in the lodge are the best in the park, and the rooms are large, lovely and filled with light. The facilities are first-rate, from the swimming pool to the bar and restaurant. But it's the location that really sets this place apart.

Transfer by Road to Lake Nakuru National Park

AFTERNOON

You'll be joining us in Lake Nakuru National Park for a guided game drive. It's a fantastic opportunity to see some of the animals you came so far to see

MEALS:

BREAKFAST, LUNCH & DINNER



Day 6 - 8: Head to Maasai Mara for a Wildlife Adventure

Highlights: Wildebeest Migration, African Big Five, Crocodiles, Hippos

Big cats are sure to be a highlight of your time in the Masai Mara, with lions, leopards and cheetahs all commonly seen stalking prey on the Mara's savannah grasslands. Elephants, giraffes, buffaloes, wildebeests, zebras, hippos and hyenas are also often seen here, sometimes in front of a background of flat-topped acacia trees. Impalas are everywhere. Bird-watchers will also love the chance to see more than 500 bird species.

ACCOMMODATION: Sentrim Mara Camp

Sentrim Mara is well located in the eastern, wildlife-filled reaches of the Masai Mara National Reserve. You'll be sleeping in safari tents that rest on elevated platforms, and the lodge grounds shelter a swimming pool, a bar and a restaurant. It's an outstanding base for your explorations of the Mara.



Activities

MORNING

DAY 6: Transfer by Road to Maasai Mara

DAY 7&8: There's no better way for you to see Serengeti than on the guided game drive we'll take you on this morning. Get your camera and binoculars ready, sit back in our vehicle, and enjoy looking for the wildlife.

AFTERNOON

You'll be heading down more safari trails in search of animals in Serengeti National Park when we take you on a guided game drive. This is the best thing about many safaris, and you'll hopefully see many animals.

MEALS:

BREAKFAST, LUNCH & DINNER



Day 9: off to Naivasha

Highlights: Great Rift Valley, Boat Riding, Hell's Gate

We think you'll love exploring Lake Naivasha, the highest (and one of the loveliest) of Kenya's Rift Valley lakes. Watch for hippos out on the lake, and for zebras and giraffes around the lakeshore.

ACCOMMODATION: Lake Naivasha Crescent Camp

You're staying at Lake Naivasha Crescent Camp, a wonderfully located tented camp that runs right down to the lakeshore. You'll sleep in large safari tents with wooden floors, private bathrooms, mosquito nets and beautiful tree-filled surrounds. The property also has a restaurant and a swimming pool. It's a terrific base for exploring the lake and surrounding area.



Activities

AFTERNOON

This afternoon you'll go on a boat trip on Lake Naivasha. It's a chance to enjoy a quiet moment or two and take in the pretty surroundings on this popular lake. Keep an eye out for hippos as you travel around.

MEALS: BREAKFAST, LUNCH & DINNER



Day 10 & 11: Close encounter with huge herds of Elephant in Amboseli

Highlights: Huge herds of Elephants, Mount Kilimanjaro

You'll be visiting one of the best safari parks in Africa when you come to Amboseli. The park is filled with big tusked elephants, and Mt Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest mountain (5895m), looms over Amboseli. This combination makes for some fantastic photos, especially when the clouds clear over the summit as they do most days around sunrise and sunset. You also have a good chance of seeing lions, cheetahs, hyenas, zebras, buffaloes, giraffes (out in the park's east), wildebeests and plenty of gazelles. The park is also terrific for birding, with 420 species recorded.

ACCOMMODATION: Amboseli Sopa Lodge

In a quiet area east of Amboseli National Park, Amboseli Sopa Lodge is a terrific place for you to stay. The large rooms have plenty of character with bold safari themes and color schemes, and the large swimming pool (which has Mt Kilimanjaro views) is good for relaxing. There's also a bar and a restaurant, as well as good service.

DAY 10: Transfer by road to Amboseli

DAY 11: Morning game drive through the park

AFTERNOON

It's time for one of the great safari experiences, a guided game drive through Amboseli. Watch for elephants, lions, and maybe even the clouds parting over Mt. Kilimanjaro.

MEALS:

BREAKFAST, LUNCH & DINNER



Day 12 - 14: Tsavo, untamed and raw Wildereness

Highlights: Red-skinned Elephants, man-eating lions, 500 different bird species

Welcome to Tsavo East, one of Kenya's largest and wildest national parks. The rugged landscape is best known for its lions (many of the males have very scruffy manes, if at all), and for its many elephants coated in Tsavo's distinctive red dust. The park's east is generally excellent for cheetah sightings, while other elusive species include the Somali ostrich, gerenuk and the extremely rare hirola antelope. Nearly 500 bird species have been sighted here

ACCOMMODATION: Man Eaters Lodge

You're not far from Tsavo West National Park at Man Eaters Lodge, a rewarding place alongside the Tsavo River and far removed from other lodges and camps. The safari tents are large, and they sit beneath high thatched canopies that protect the tents from the harsh Tsavo sun and occasional rain. Relax in the pool, or in the bar and restaurant

Activities

MORNING

This morning you'll go on a guided game drive through Tsavo, looking for elephants, rhinos and big cats as you go

AFTERNOON

Come with us this afternoon for a guided game drive. We love showing off the landscapes and wildlife of Tsavo Park, and part of the excitement is about never quite knowing which animals are going to appear.

MEALS:

BREAKFAST, LUNCH & DINNER



TSAVO

Day 15 - 20: Relax on an Idyllic beACH paradise

You'll find it's easy to fall in love with Diani Beach, one of Kenya's most beautiful beaches. Pristine sands backed by palm forests make this one of our favorite spots along the Indian Ocean coast, and there are coral mosques, a monkey sanctuary, and a cool beachside vibe to go with the fabulous views

ACCOMMODATION: Diani Sea Resort

You can't be any closer to the beach in Diani than you are at Diani Sea Resort. It's an excellent place to stay, with bright, light-filled rooms. Enjoy also beautiful grounds filled with palm trees, and everything you need to relax, including swimming pools, a restaurant and bars right by the pool and by the beach. You're also guaranteed Indian Ocean views.
